Nurse News

Welcome Back to School!!

I would like to share some information on MAUES' current process for reporting and clearing positive Covid cases.

If your child tests positive for Covid, please use the following link to report the case to the school:

https://forms.gle/YAE317qRstrQtM5f8

After your child completes their 5 day isolation they will need a DPHSS clearance to return to school. Your child will be required to wear a mask at school for an additional 5 days.

If your child tests at an approved test site (ex. DPHSS, private clinic) the results are automatically sent to DPHSS and you can request a clearance at covidclearance@dphss.guam.gov

If you test using a home test kit, you must first send your result to dphss.surveillance@dphss.guam.gov then request for a clearance at covidclearance@dphs.guam.gov

If your child is a close contact to someone who tests positive for Covid and is FULLY vaccinated they DO NOT have to quarantine and can attend school unless they develop symptoms.

If your child is a close contact to someone who tests positive for Covid and is NOT fully vaccinated they must quarantine at home for 10 days. If they test negative after Day 5 (at an approved test site) they can return to school. You child will be required to wear a mask at school for an additional 5 days.

If your child has completed their Covid vaccine series please send a copy of their Covid shot card or email a copy to Nurse Kim at kkedusma@gdoe.net.

Please remember to keep your children home if they are feeling ill. Let's all do our part to keep our children and employees safe from Covid.




