This quarter started with a review of kinder skills and ways to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Then, we moved on to the 1st quarter priority standards which are:

Science: NGSS 2-LS4-1 Make observations of plants and animals to compare the diversity of life in different habitats.

Social Studies: GDOE 2.4.1 Define and give examples of the responsibilities of a good citizen.
