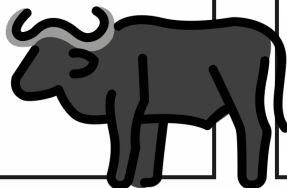

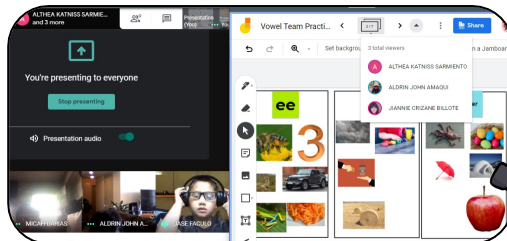
1ST GRADE

4TH GRADE

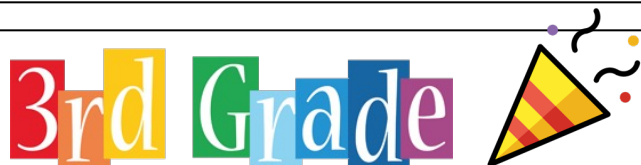
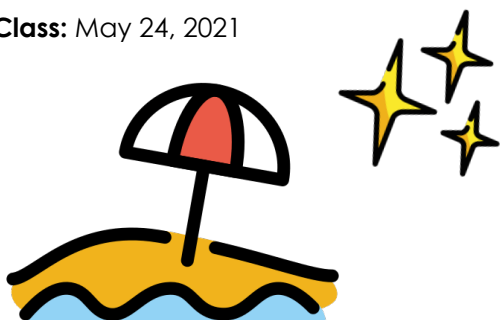

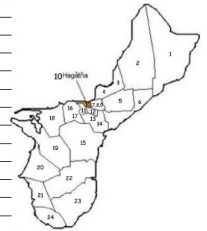
Chamoru: Acha'ikak Pinenta/Yininga' (CHamoru Poster/Drawing Contest)

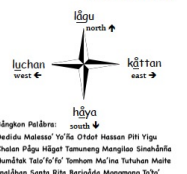
